

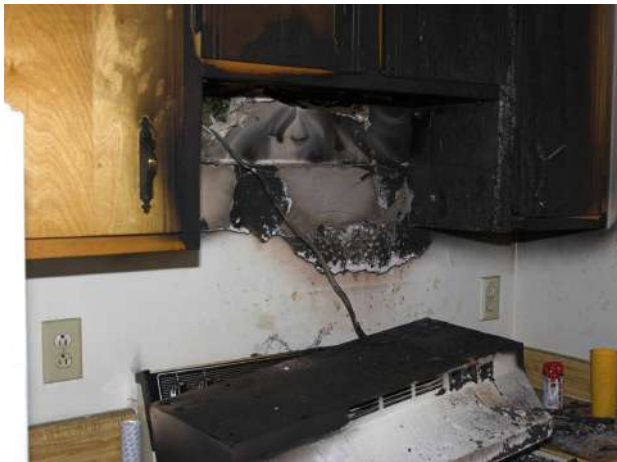


Loss Event: Fire and water damage restoration
multifamily apartment unit

Southfield, MI

A fire that began in one unit of the apartment complex quickly spread to other units engulfing the building in flames. All 16 units of the building suffered extensive structural damage from fire, smoke and soot.

The massive amount of water that was needed to extinguish the fire caused additional structural damage to the walls, ceilings and floors, affecting both levels of the complex. In total, the damages resulting from fire, water, smoke and soot, were in excess of \$1,000,000.



The scope of the recovery work included:

- Site stabilization
- Providing water cleanup and dehumidification services
- Contents pack out and pack in
- Contents cleaning and restoration
- Structural demolition to damaged sections of the complex
- Structural cleaning services to remove smoke and soot residue
- Building reconstruction and restoration services
